

Are all aggregation switches fiber optic ports



Overview

With AXIS D8308 Fiber Aggregation Switch you can connect multiple Axis devices using fiber midspans over long distances. It also enables easy expansion by simply adding more fiber or network. Port aggregation can increase maximum throughput, and allow for network redundancy. Note that these performance improvements will only occur when multiple clients are passing. These ports are usually Gigabit Ethernet or higher-speed fiber interfaces that can handle large amounts of data transmission needs. The following figure shows an FS-1048E aggregation-layer switch.
