FTTC stands for Fibre to the Cabinet. First of all the fibre doesn't connect to your router, it connects to an optical modem (ONT) that is fitted where the cable enters. Of course, I was aware of that having already investigated ONTs! Fiber to the cabinet is a connectivity technology that is based on a combination of fiber optic cable and copper cable. This mix of fibre and copper allows faster speeds than old-school ADSL.
