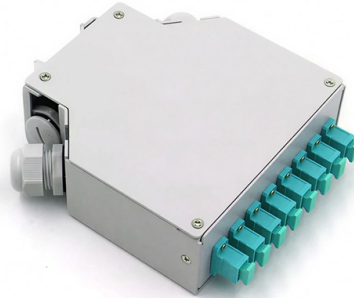
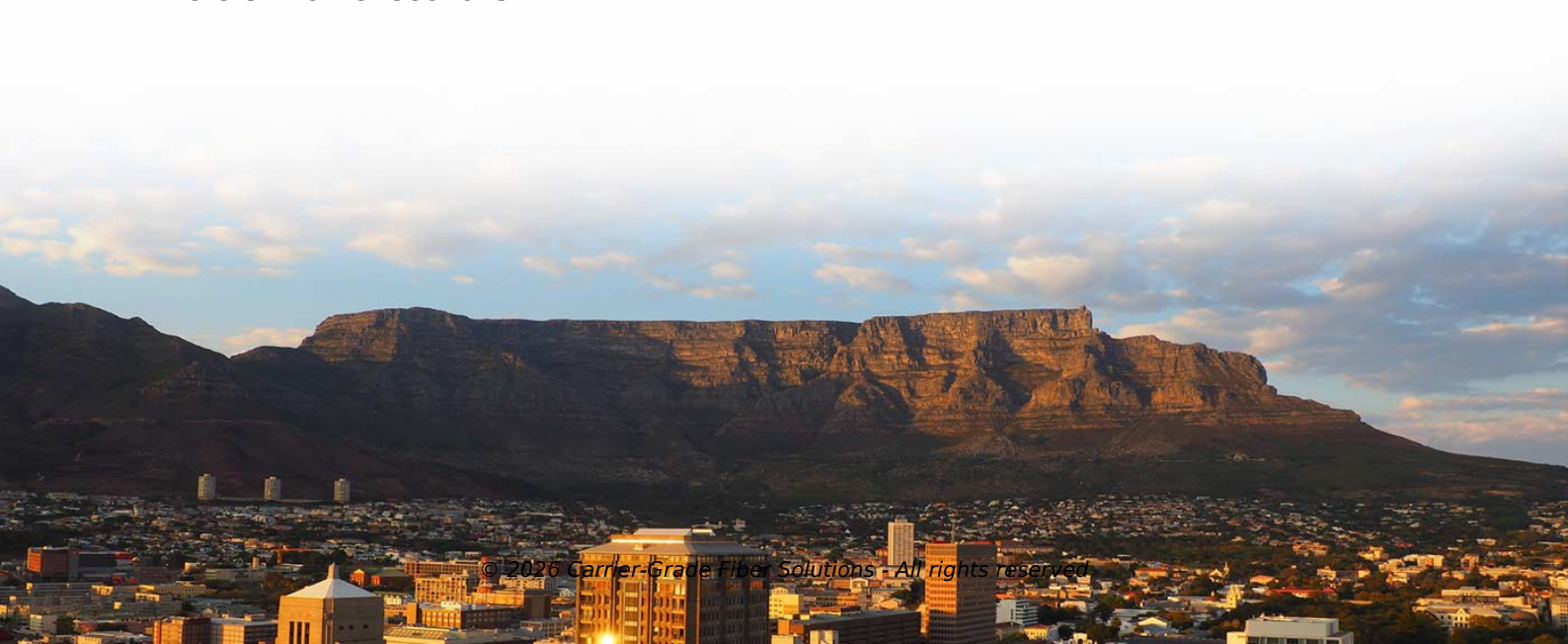


Fiber optic cable length and overhead line length
