

How to connect the patch cord to the aggregation switch



Overview

Now when it comes to cabling the trick is pretty simple to follow. As you do this your service loop will stay within a small 12 port width from it's closest patched and furthest patched quarter of the ports. Patch panel and switch are commonly used to connect devices in data centers and telecom rooms, and they are usually mounted on a server rack. None the less, we all want it to look as neat as it can when we are done. I'm going to show you my practice when it comes to patching which can be easily modified. I have one 24 port fully loaded patch panel (ports are arranged in a single row) and one SF300-24 port switch (arranged in 2 rows, each of 12 ports) and I want to connect them. Now the connections from the PC would reach the back-side of patch panel (RJ45 on PC side, connected to the keystone). How do I plug the switch into the patch panel?

Do I get a new line and punch it into the patch panel or can I just plug in a cable into the front of it?

Very confused on where to start, please help! If you have an existing patch panel the short answer to "can I just plug in a cable into the front. The Aggregation switch works just like any switch, the main difference is the use of SFP+ connections instead of Ethernet, which allows for connections over fiber or DAC.
