

How to handle a tripped circuit breaker in the primary distribution box



Overview

To fix a tripped breaker, flip the switch to the “off” position, and then to the “on” position to reset the breaker. The power should come back on within one or two seconds. If the handle pops back or won't go into the “on” position, you may have a bad breaker or another, more. Frequent tripping of your distribution box is a critical alarm, not just an annoyance. For facility managers, electricians, and project owners operating overseas—from industrial plants in the Middle East to solar farms in Southeast Asia—these unexpected shutdowns mean costly downtime, safety risks.
