

Main switch copper busbar in distribution box



Overview

A distribution box has several important parts. Each part does something special:

Main Switch: This switch controls all electricity coming into the box.

Circuit Breakers (MCBs): These protect each circuit.

In electric power distribution, a busbar (also bus bar) is a metallic strip or bar, typically housed inside switchgear, panel boards, and busway enclosures for local high current power distribution, transmission, or switching substations. They are also used to connect high voltage equipment at.

Busbars are the backbone of a low-voltage switchboard: rigid conductors that collect and distribute current safely between incoming devices and outgoing feeders. In most assemblies you will find horizontal main bars, vertical risers, neutral and equipment-ground buses, and purpose-designed. Greeting, In Linergy catalogue (Reference LVYED213001EN) on pages 6 and 7 there is a depiction of submain busbars of several rows being fed from main distribution block. How are cross section and insulation material properties of these conductors being determined given that they are not overload. The switchgear is provided with a continuous electrolytic copper earth-ing busbar, with a cross-section suit-able for the proper switchgear short-circuit rating and pre-set on both sides for connection to the earthing network.
