Overview

Explanation: A straight-through cable can be used to connect a computer or a router to a switch. This means you only need to run a single cable for your setup. The information can be accessed by the user through these subnets. The access layer consists of layer 3 switches, which take routed and switched data packets from the. The switch has two console ports: a USB 5-pin mini-Type B port on the front panel (see image below) and an RJ-45 console port on the rear panel. The USB Type A-to-USB mini-Type B cable is not. In general when you connect two similar devices ie, switch to switch, router to router, workstation to workstation, you will use a cross-over cable, and for all others - use a straight through. Switch port type should be configured according to the requirement considering the factors like network architecture, speed and.
